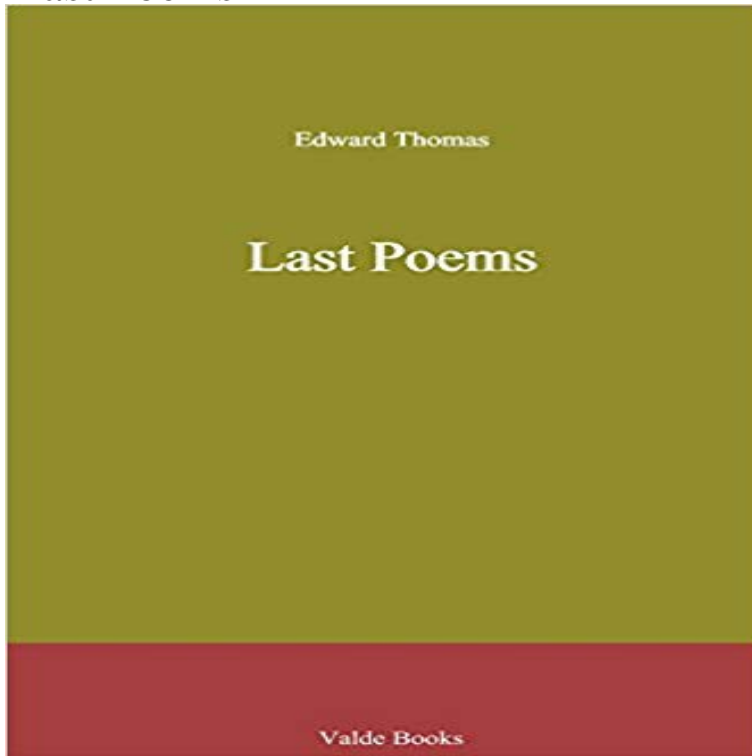


Last Poems
